It's fun to follow him around his lab and listen to his stories. "With the right kind of light, I can see the finest details in my work," he adds.

#### **The scientist**

A personable pragmatist, Sascha Hein's scientific work focuses on the physical aspects of light and how it can influence color perception and the quality of dental work. An expert in color science and optical physics, he always manages to balance his enthusiasm for the scientific findings of light optics. With pragmatic sobriety on the one hand and a love of dental technology on the other, he is dedicated to imitating natural teeth. In the film, he explains the importance of optimal lighting for precise work. "Good lighting," he points out, "takes the strain off the eyes, improves the working conditions, and allows the finest details to be captured with precision."
